## Lausanne Free Church Covid 19 Protection Plan

Issued 2 May 2021

The following is based on the regulations and issued by the Office Fédéral de la Santé Publique and the Canton of Vaud.

- A maximum of 50 people can be present at a meeting.
- Masks must be worn at all times whilst inside the church premises. The only exceptions are children under 12 and those who cannot wear a mask for a medical reason.
- Please use the hand sanitiser on arrival.
- At the entrance you will be guided directly to your allocated seats. Please remain seated for the whole time you are in the church unless you need to use the toilet.
- On your chair you will find your hymnbook and Bible. Please try not to put them on the floor and leave them on your chair after the service.
- We must maintain 1.5 metres distance both inside and outside the church.
- We must remain seated throughout the service including when singing. The front door will be opened during singing.
- After the service you may stay in your chair to talk to those nearby but do not walk around the church. If you wish to speak to someone else, please go outside the church.
- The premises will be cleaned twice a week, before and after the meetings.
- The authorities suggest that people in the vulnerable category (65 and over or those with certain underlying health conditions) should consider carefully before attending.
- Anyone who has any symptoms of Covid-19 or anyone who has had contact with such a person must stay at home in accordance with the quarantine rules.
- If within 5 days of being present at a meeting you develop Covid-19, please inform our Pastor Alan Hill.
